There is a mistake in the title of Docket 160241-TP; the name of one of the companies, INdigital (TY127), should not have a period after "Inc" according to the company contact: Eric Hartman Indigital VP of Business Development.

The names in the PAA and the CO when they were first certificated are both ok,

but the docket title in the CMS has:

when it should say:

when it should say:
