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CHAIRMAN BROWN: Moving on to Item 3. Hi. Good morning.

MR. LEE: Good morning, Commissioners. Daniel Lee on behalf of staff.

Item 3 addresses Duke Energy's petition regarding its proposed revenue requirement and tariffs for the Hines chillers uprate project. The Hines chillers uprate project was approved by the Commission in 2014 in a need determination proceeding. Recovery of such cost is allowed under the settlement agreement approved by the Commission in 2013.

Staff's recommended revenue requirement is based on the capital structure from the most recent earnings surveillance report and is approximately \$28,000 lower than Duke Energy proposed.

No customers filed comments in this docket. A Duke Energy representative is present to answer questions. The Office of Public Counsel would like to make a comment. Staff is prepared to answer questions.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you so much.

Mr. Rehwinkel, welcome, and Ms. Triplett.

MR. REHWINKEL: Thank you, Madam Chair, Commissioners.

The Public Counsel is here to support the

staff's recommendation. When we reached agreement with

Duke in 2013, we specifically agreed that what we're

doing here today would be done the way it's being done

4 by your staff.

Normally if a company came in and asked for a \$19 million increase in rates, we would ask that the Commission suspend the tariff, hold a hearing, and then implement rates after it was determined what the appropriate rates would be. However, in this case, we agreed that this process would happen where the tariff would go into effect, a party would be afforded an opportunity for hearing, but the revenues would be collected subject to refund as per the Wilson line of cases. That's what you're doing here today. That's why we're not asking for the tariff to be suspended. And at this point in time, we agree with the calculations of the revenue requirement of the company, and we will not be asking for a hearing in this case.

We do have an opportunity to challenge any excess costs, not that we expect there to be any. It's a theoretical right that we would have, and Duke has done a good job in bringing this project in. Thank you.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you, Mr. Rehwinkel. I did suspect that you were going to say those words, so I appreciate them being said on the record.
