## PROCEEDINGS

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CHAIRMAN BROWN: Moving on to Camachee,

Camachee. Item -- Camachee, Item 6, Camachee.

MR. JOHNSON: Good morning, Commissioners.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Good morning.

MR. JOHNSON: I'm Charlie Johnson speaking on behalf of Commission staff today.

Item No. 6 addresses Camachee Cove Yacht

Harbor Utility's application for a limited proceeding.

The utility is a Class C utility providing water service to approximately 100 customers in St. Johns County.

Unlike a full rate case, Camachee's request consists of only the recovery of the revenue requirement authorized by the Commission in Docket No. 090230, plus the price index increases authorized since that time, rate case expense incurred in this proceeding, and regulatory assessment fees. The utility is seeking to recover no new items of expense, investment, or changes to cost of capital. This recommendation is for the approval of an increase in service rates to allow the utility to generate the previously authorized revenue requirement price index increases and rate case expense incurred in this proceeding.

There's been some customer correspondence in this docket, and the utility is present for today's

agenda. Staff is prepared to answer any questions at this time.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you, Mr. Johnson. I just see Office of Public Counsel. I don't see the utility present.

MR. JOHNSON: They are here, they just -- CHAIRMAN BROWN: Okay. Thank you.

All right. Commissioners -- Public Counsel, would you like to address the Commission?

MS. MORSE: No, we don't have any comments in particular. If you have any questions, we'll be happy to answer.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you. I do have a question. My understanding was that there were customers that were concerned with this docket. Could you address those concerns?

MS. MORSE: Well, customers were initially -any rate increase is difficult, and they wanted to know
the basis for the increase. They wanted, in particular,
maybe a fuller investigation. And through discussions
with staff and a subsequent data request, additional
information was obtained to the satisfaction, I believe,
of the customers in that the -- they got the information
that they wanted in terms of the basis, and I think they
felt their concerns were listened to, addressed.
