ORDER CLOSING FILE

On November 10, 2016, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) received a request for administrative hearing from the Respondent, Sunrise Utilities. The request challenged the Department of Health in Polk County's (DOH) decision to issue a Notice of Violation and Orders for Corrective Action against Sunrise Utilities, LLC, and Alturas Utilities, LLC (OGC Case No. 15-653PW1739).¹

On March 30, 2017, after receiving a Notice of Settlement and Joint Motion for Remand with an attached executed Consent Order, the assigned administrative law judge issued an order closing the file of the Division of Administrative Hearings and relinquishing jurisdiction. In the executed Consent Order, DOH voluntarily dismissed Alturas Utilities, LLC. There being no
