PETITION FOR EXPEDITED REVIEW OF NXX-X CODE DENIAL

Teleport Communications America, LLC - FL (“TCAL”) pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 52.15(g)(iv), the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) Order FCC 00-104, and the Florida Public Service Commission (“Commission”) Order No. PSC-01-1873-PCO-TL, petition the Commission to review the Pooling Administrator’s (“NeuStar”) denial of TCAL’s request for additional numbering resources in the Ocala rate center. In support of this petition, TCAL states:

PARTIES

1. TCAL is a corporation organized and formed under the laws of the State of New Jersey.
2. NeuStar is an independent non-governmental entity, which is responsible for administering and managing the numbering resources in pooling areas. See 47 C.F.R. § 52.20(d).

JURISDICTION

3. The Commission has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to Industry Numbering Committees (INC) Number Pooling Guidelines Sections 3.7 and 12(c). This provision provides that a carrier may challenge NeuStar’s decision to deny numbering resources to the appropriate regulatory authority.

BACKGROUND AND REQUEST FOR RELIEF

4. The Ocala rate center consists of 1 switching entity, OCALFLXAX4Z. Ocala has approximately 600 numbers available but not of the format stipulated in the customer’s

Letter of Intent. TCAL owns 352-512-6 with 30 available numbers and 352-644-2 with less than 500 available.

5. On April 7, 2017, TCAL requested 1000 consecutive numbers from NeuStar, for the Ocala rate center, to satisfy the customer's request.

6. At the time of the request, the Ocala rate center had a MTE of 4.3 months and utilization of ~70%.

7. April 7, 2017, NeuStar denied TCAL's request because TCAL had not met the utilization criteria, notwithstanding the fact that TCAL is unable to provide the numbering resources requested by the specific customer. See Attachment 1. Pursuant to Commission Order No. PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL, attached to this Petition is the customer contact information. See Attachment 2.

8. As discussed above, both the FCC Order and the INC guidelines provide that state regulatory authorities have the power and authority to review NeuStar's decision to deny a request for numbering resources. See INC Number Pooling Guidelines Sections 3.7 and 12(c).

9. Under earlier MTE procedures used by NANPA, waivers or exceptions were granted when customer hardships could be demonstrated or when the service provider's inventory did not have the specific number format to meet the customer's specific request. The current process is arbitrary and results in (1) decisions contrary to the public interest and welfare of consumers in Florida; and (2) decisions that do not necessarily promote the efficient use of telephone numbers.

10. TCAL requests that the Commission reverse NeuStar's decision to withhold numbering resources on the following grounds:

(a) NeuStar's denial of numbering resources to TCAL interferes with TCAL's ability to serve its customer in Florida.

(b) As a result of NeuStar's denial of the request for additional numbering resources, TCAL is unable to provide telecommunications services to its customer as required under Florida law.

WHEREFORE, TCAL requests:

1. The Commission review the decision of NeuStar to deny TCAL's request for additional numbering resources for the Ocala rate center; and
2. The Commission direct NeuStar to provide the requested numbering resources for the Ocala rate center as discussed above.

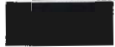
