



3. Pursuant to the requirements in this docket, FPUC, concurrently with the filing of this petition, files the testimony of Ms. Michelle Napier, along with Schedule A-7 (Exhibit MDN-1) for its consolidated gas division for the period January 2016 through December 2016.
4. As indicated in the testimony of Ms. Napier, FPUC’s final true-up amount for the period January 2016 through December 2016, including interest, net of estimated true-up for the same period, is an over-recovery of \$3,403. This reflects the difference between the

Company's actual over-recovery of \$1,645,762, for the period as compared to its estimated over-recovery of \$1,642,359 for the same period, which was based on six months of actual and six months of estimated data.

WHEREFORE, FPUC respectfully requests that the Commission enter its Order approving the Company's final true up amount for the period January 2016 through December 2016.

2 was allowed by the Commission during the November 2016 hearing?

3 A. As recognized in Order No. PSC-16-0532-FOF-GU, in Docket No.  
4 160003-GU, FPUC had an anticipated over-recovery of \$1,642,359, based  
5 upon six months of actual and six months of projected data.

7 A. We prepared and pre-filed composite Exhibit MDN-1, containing  
8 Schedule A-7, Final PGA Over/Under Recovery for the Period January  
9 2016 through December 2016.
