**RE:** Docket No.170113-TX – Petition for expedited review of NXX-X code denial by Number Pooling Administrator for the Melbourne rate center, by Teleport Communications America, LLC-FL.

---

On May 9, 2017, Teleport Communications America, LLC-FL filed a request for additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar) for the Melbourne rate center (ORLDFLCLXAY) switch. Teleport Communications America, LLC-FL requested one block to meet the request of a specific customer for 1000 consecutive numbers in the format of NPA- NXX.4XXX. On May 9, 2017, Teleport Communications America, LLC-FL request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the utilization criteria.

On May15, 2017, Teleport Communications America, LLC-FL filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar’s decision. In accordance with Section 2.07C.5.e. of the Administrative Procedures Manual (APM), staff has examined the Teleport Communications America, LLC-FL petition and has determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has customers in need of numbering resources.
- 2) The carrier has shown that it will be unable to provide services to these potential customers because of NeuStar’s denial of the numbering resources.
- 3) Customers will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of Section 2.07C.5.e. of the APM have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (June 8, 2017), as outlined in the APM expedited code denial process. NeuStar should be directed to provide Teleport Communications America, LLC-FL the needed numbering resources to meet its customer’s needs in the Melbourne exchange, (ORLDFLCLXAY) switch.
