On May 10, 2017, Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC) filed highlighted information in FPUC's Response to Staff's First Request For Production Of Documents (Nos. 1-3), pursuant to a Notice Of Intent to Request Confidential Classification (DN 04773-17).

On May 19, 2017, pursuant to Section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, FPUC requested confidential classification of highlighted information in FPUC's Response to Staff's First Request For Production Of Documents (Nos. 1-3), (DN 04942-17, and cross-referenced to DN 04773-17). The Request For Confidential Classification was filed on May 19, 2017 (DN 04941-17).

On May 30, 2017, FPUC made a filing to correct and amend a page from the POD Response. FPUC filed a corrected page identified as Bates Label FPU-01-0037 (DN 05095-17). In its cover letter accompanying the correction, the Company requested that the Request For Confidential Classification filed on May 19, 2017 (DN 04941-17), also apply to corrected page.

Staff has reviewed FPUC's confidentiality request, and in staff's opinion, the request meets the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093, Florida Statutes. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information included in Document Nos. 04942-17 and 05095-17 be approved.
