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PROCEEDINGS 1 CHAIRMAN BROWN: Item 5. 2 MR. BUYS: Good afternoon, Commissioners. 3 I'm Dale Buys with staff. 4 Madam Chair, if I may, I would like to 5 acknowledge that this will be Anwar Archer's last agenda 6 7 with us. He's accepted a position in an agency in North Carolina, and he will be moving up there, I guess, in 8 9 the middle of the month. CHAIRMAN BROWN: Mr. Archer, we're going to 10 11 miss you. 12 MR. ARCHER: Thank you. I'll miss everyone 13 too. 14 CHAIRMAN BROWN: What are you going to be doing up there? 15 MR. ARCHER: I'll be working with non-profits 16 17 and low-income families in budgeting and monitoring. CHAIRMAN BROWN: That's good. Love your 18 19 outfit today too. MR. ARCHER: Thank you. Go 'Gators. 20 21 CHAIRMAN BROWN: All right. Thanks. 22 Mr. Archer. 23 MR. ARCHER: Okay. I'm Anwar Archer with the Commission staff. 24 25 Item 5 is staff's recommendation in Docket FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

No. 170006-WS regarding the annual reestablishment of the authorized range of returns on equity for water and wastewater utilities pursuant to Section 367.081 of the *Florida Statutes*.

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Staff recommends that the leverage formula be approved by the Commission as it was in 2016 and to continue to be used until readdressed. The Commission has approved the same leverage formula for the past six years, and staff believes that the range of returns on common equity currently in place continues to be more reasonable than the range of returns on common equity derived from this year's leverage formula using the most recent financial data.

In addition, staff recommends a workshop be scheduled for the fall to review and update, if necessary, the methodology used to determine the leverage formula.

At the Commission's discretion, the workshop can either be a formal workshop led by the Commissioners or an informal workshop led by the Commission staff.

If any changes to the methodology are made during the workshop, staff can file a new recommendation for the Commission's decision at a subsequent Commission Conference.

No customers have been contacted during -- in

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000004 regards to this docket, and no one has requested to 1 2 speak on this item. CHAIRMAN BROWN: Commissioner Polmann does. 3 Commissioner Polmann. 4 5 COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Thank you, Madam Chairman. 6 7 I want to express my gratitude to staff. We had good discussion on this item. I had a number of 8 9 questions which have been addressed. We have mentioned a workshop a couple of 10 times, and I would advocate for a Commission workshop at 11 the appropriate time. We can discuss that further in 12 13 the future. Thank you very much. 14 CHAIRMAN BROWN: Commissioner Graham. 15 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Thank you, Madam Chair. I -- this is an issue that comes up quite 16 17 often. We're all quite familiar with it. I don't have 18 a problem with having a workshop that may be noticed so it's open for Commissioners. I don't think it needs to 19 be Commission led. So that way if any of us want to 20 21 partake, we can do that. 22 CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you, Commissioner 23 Graham. Any others? 24 I was leaning toward Commissioner Graham's 25 recommendation as well. We've been using this info

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since 2011, and it does seem to be a little stale. And I had some discussions as well with staff, and you all do a very fine job at this work.

Wouldn't it make more sense using a proxy group, though, that is more reflective of the wastewater and water industry in setting the leverage formula? We're using natural gas utilities here, some of which have been consolidated, merged, acquired. A little comment on that.

MR. BUYS: Yes. The proxy group using the regulated gas utilities was established in the hearing in '01 and then reaffirmed in '08, and that's one of the purposes of the workshop is to look into whether or not we can use a more -- a proxy group that's more reflective of the risks associated with the smaller Florida water companies as mergers and acquisitions have reduced the available number of gas utilities to use in that proxy group.

CHAIRMAN BROWN: Yeah. I definitely don't think it's an apples-to-apples comparison here. So the workshop would occur in October. And if there is -- say information develops that would lean staff to recommend a change in the leverage formula with the updated information, when would you come back to the Commission? Prior to the start of 2018? Or would you -- because the

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1	statute says that we must set the leverage formula at		
2	least once a year, at least.		
3	MR. BUYS: Yes, Commissioner. Yes, Madam		
4	Chairman. We could after the workshop, if it was		
5	decided that we need to update the leverage formula, we		
6	could at that time bring it back to the Commission even		
7	before 2018 with the updated proxy group or whatever		
8	changes we make to the methodology.		
9	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you.
