Item 6 is staff's recommendation on the application for transfer of majority organizational control of water certificate No. 626-W for B&C Water Resources, LLC, and water and wastewater certificate Nos. 635-W and 545-S for D&E Water Resources, LLC.

B&C is providing water service to approximately seven customers, and D&E is currently not serving any customers. There have been no customer comments filed in this docket either supporting or opposing the transfer, and no protests were filed within the protest period.

Staff recommends that the Commission should grant the transfer. Mr. Bruce May is here on behalf of the utility to answer questions. Staff is also available to answer any questions.

They have recently acquired Plum Creek, which is 6 7 a large real estate investment trust, and these utilities were owned by the REIT, the REIT/Plum Creek. 8 9 And as a result of the upstream change of majority organizational control, we felt it was out of an 10 11 abundance of caution to get the Commission approval of 12 that. 13 CHAIRMAN BROWN: Very prudent. Thank you, 14 Mr. May. Commissioners, any other questions? If not, 15 we're ripe for a motion. 16 17 **COMMISSIONER GRAHAM:** Move staff. 18 CHAIRMAN BROWN: Is there a second? 19 COMMISSIONER PATRONIS: Second. 2.0 CHAIRMAN BROWN: All those in favor, say aye. 21 (Vote taken.) 22 Thank you.
