On March 8, 2017, the Florida Division of Chesapeake Utilities Corporation ("CFG") filed a petition to amend the 2017 gas reliability infrastructure program (GRIP) factor for commercial customers in rate class FTS-9 and to issue refunds to the affected customers. This petition was approved on May 19, 2017, by Order No. PSC-17-0194-TRF-GU.

The amended GRIP factor was effective with the Company's May billing period. On May 24, 2017, each customer was personally called to explain the impending credit. Credits were processed and applied to each customer account on May 30, 2017 in total of \$71,460.62, including interest.
