2	CHAIRMAN BROWN: And on to Item 15.
3	MS. DRAPER: Item 15 is a joint petition from
4	Florida City Gas and Florida Crystals Corporation
5	for approval of an amended and restated gas
6	transportation agreement. The agreement is a
7	special contract that includes the negotiated rates
8	and terms between City Gas and Crystals that, with
9	the Commission's approval, will resolve all issues
10	in this docket.
11	Staff recommends approval of the agreement.
12	City Gas and Crystals are represented here today
13	and wish to briefly address the Commission and are
14	available to answer questions. And also, OPC filed
15	a notice of intervention yesterday and wishes to
16	make a statement.
17	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you.
18	Who would like to go first?
19	MR. SELF: I'll I'll jump in, Madam
20	Chairman, if it's all right.
21	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Sure.
22	MR. SELF: Thank you, Commissioner. Good
23	morning. Floyd Self, on behalf of Florida City
24	Gas, the Berger Singerman law firm.
25	We support the staff recommendation. We very

1	much especially appreciate the encouragement that
2	the Commission has offered to the parties to
3	settle. We are very happy to be here today with
4	the opportunity to present you with this
5	settlement. We also thank the staff for their
6	support and encouragement throughout this process.
7	I have some folks here, including Carolyn
8	Bermudez and Archie Hickerson, who can address any
9	technical or specific questions you have. But we
10	certainly support the staff recommendation and urge
11	you to pass it.
12	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you.
13	MR. SELF: Thank you.
14	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you.
15	Mr. Wright.
16	MR. WRIGHT: Thank you, Madam Chairman,
17	Commissioners. Schef Wright on behalf of Florida
18	Crystals Corporation.
19	I'll be brief. We appreciate the staff's and
20	the Commission's support, encouragement, and
21	flexibility as we worked through renegotiating our
22	amended and restated gas transportation agreement.
23	And we particularly appreciate your expeditious
24	processing of of our joint petition for approval
25	of the amended GTA.

1	While we've made it clear we don't agree with
2	every aspect of the staff's analysis, we do
3	thoroughly, completely support the staff's
4	recommendation approval. We're very grateful for
5	your quick processing. And I'm happy to answer any
6	questions.
7	Thank you, again.
8	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Thank you, Mr. Wright.
9	And Mr. Rehwinkel.
10	MR. REHWINKEL: Good morning, Madam Chairman
11	and Commissioners. Charles Rehwinkel with the
12	Office of Public Counsel.
13	We've as staff stated, we filed a notice of
14	intervention yesterday. We would like to state for
15	the record that we believe that the contract before
16	you appears reasonable as presented in the petition
17	and in staff's recommendation; however, all
18	financial information, cost support, rates, and
19	refund calculation and amounts are confidential, as
20	they should be.
21	The Public Counsel is not here today to raise
22	an objection to the contract or to the
23	confidentiality. I want to be clear about that.
24	We have intervened at this time so that we can have
25	reasonable access to the information that has been

1	presented under the protections that are available
2	to a party. And we expect to work with the company
3	and your staff, perhaps, to access and review that
4	information.
5	Even though there is an opportunity for a
6	hearing through the PAA process or the contract/
7	tariff approval process before you, we are not
8	contemplating asking for a hearing. We just wanted
9	to tell you that we do expect to test the
10	representations that are made today and that are
11	contained in the recommendation in the next rate
12	case that City Gas files.
13	So, with that, we're in support of the
14	recommendation.
15	CHAIRMAN BROWN: Okay. Thank you,
16	Mr. Rehwinkel.
17	Commissioners, I just want to say, I am elated
18	that this was resolved amicably and without the
19	need for a painstaking hearing. So, I really
20	commend the parties for working together and
21	collaboratively on resolving this issue. And
22	appreciate it.
23	Commissioners, any questions or comments? If
24	not, we're ripe for a motion.
