The change from CFLs to LEDs reflects changing technologies and allows TECO's programs to continue to advance the policy objectives of FEECA.

There are no customer comments received in relation to this petition, and staff recommends that costs associated with the modified programs be eligible for cost recovery through TECO's energy conservation cost recovery factor. The utility is present and is available to answer questions. Staff is also available to answer any questions.
