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CHAIRMAN BROWN: Item 10.

MR. HIGGINS: Good morning, Commissioners.

Devlin Higgins with Commission staff.

Item 10 addresses Florida Power & Light's petition for establishment of a depreciation rate associated with energy storage equipment.

Staff's recommendation, as detailed in its memorandum before you today, are based on Commission rules and formulated through review and analysis of FPL's petition as well as responses to staff's data requests. Staff notes that it is not aware of any public concerns on this matter.

And establishing the depreciation period and rate is -- it's something that we're trying to figure out. And also recognition that at any time this Commission can take a second look at it to make sure that the rate is set at the appropriate level.

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COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Thank you, Madam

Question or request. Could you please elaborate for us briefly what's included in the description, not necessarily account specifics but a description of the terminology "energy storage equipment" just so we are clear in this context here what's being referred to generally?

MR. HIGGINS: Yes. There was inverters, equipment to attach the batteries to the grid wires, cabling, that, that type of stuff. We do have an exact listing. Excuse me. Equipment to integrate the solar facilities; moreover, basic -- basically hardware, wires and such is mostly --

COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Okay. So if I could just reflect on that. This is associated with battery storage and the appurtenances principally derived with their solar energy efforts; is that a fair statement?

MR. HIGGINS: That is a -- it seems to be what they're looking at, just going through data requests. But there's also onsite facility, reliable backup electric -- electricity as well as some small transmission conditioning functions.
