Commission Order No. PSC-17-0209-PAA-WU, required that Bocilla Utilities, Inc. (“Utility”) make Commission Ordered Adjustments to its books within 90 days of the PAA Order becoming final, to wit, September 22, 2017. The Utility requests an extension of 90 days, through December 21, 2017, within which to book the COAs. The good cause for this request is that the Utility only has one administrative person and the Utility’s priority has been working on the refund for customers per the PAA Order, redoing rate structure with computer consultants for implementing new rates approved by the PAA Order, in addition to normal operational requirements. In addition, this is the Utility’s first time having to make COAs. The recent hurricane has also hindered the Utility’s efforts in booking the COAs.
