My aveage usage for the Augto Sep time period over the last 3 years was 755 kwh, Duke billed for anestimated 1028 kwh this year when power was out for 3 days of the period, then hey estimated the amount supplied by my solar panels as 0, when it averaged 665 over the last 3 years. So I got an\$82 bill which should have been \$10. Need to force utilities to either wait for power to come back on and get a real reading to bill or estimate withing 5% of reality and use the same esitmating algorithm for both usage and supply, not just the one that gets them the most money. Force them to be fair to the public not their bottom line.
