

By Order No. PSC-2017-0383-PAA-SU, in Docket No. 20160165-SU, issued October 4, 2017, the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) approved a change in Beaches Sewer System's (utility) main extension and guaranteed revenue charges. The utility's existing customer connection and plant capacity charges remain unchanged. Additionally, the utility's Allowance for Funds Prudently Invested (AFPI) charges have been discontinued. A schedule of the revised service availability charges are set forth below.
