Pursuant to Section 366.093, (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL or Company) requests confidential classification of certain information filed in response to staff discovery, in the above referenced docket, dated November 28, 2017. This recommendation specifically addresses FPL's response to Staff's 1<sup>st</sup> set of interrogatories, Nos. 16 and 17.

The Company is claiming confidentiality of supplemental information provided in response to staff's 1st set of interrogatories, Nos. 16 and 17, under Section 366.093(3)(c), F.S., Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S., and Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Per the Statute, proprietary of confidential business information includes, but is not limited to; Subsection (c) "Security measures, systems or procedures," Subsection (d) "[i]nformation concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms," and Subsection (e) "[i]nformation relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information."

The information provided in response to Staff Interrogatory No. 16 for which confidential treatment is being sought can be described as the Company's transmission planning findings used in evaluating resource plans. This information is confidential under Subsection (e) and partially confidential under Subsection (c). The information provided in response to Staff Interrogatory No. 17 for which confidential treatment is being sought can be described as the Company's projected annual operation and maintenance (O&M) and capital replacement costs associated with the continued operation of Lauderdale Units 4 and 5. This information is confidential under Subsection (d) and Subsection (e).

Staff has reviewed the information FPL filed in response to Staff Interrogatories Nos. 16 and 17, as well as the Company's confidentiality request. It is staff's opinion that the information that is the subject of this request meets the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093(3)(c), F.S., Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S., and Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S.
