

FAR NOTICE OF DISPOSITION OF WAIVER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the Florida Public Service Commission that Utility Inc. of Florida's petition for waiver from Rule 25-30.030(5)(b), Florida Administrative Code, filed August 9, 2017, in Docket No. 20170174-SU was partially approved by the Commission by Order No. PSC-2017-0387-PAA-SU, issued October 11, 2017, consummated by Order No. PSC-2017-0422-CO-SU, issued November 6, 2017. The rule addresses the customer noticing provisions for an application to amend a utility's service territory. The petition was partially approved on the basis that the purpose of the underlying statute would be achieved by other means and strict application of the rule would create substantial hardship. Notice of the petition was published in the FAR on August 21, 2017.
