2	COMMISSIONER BROWN: All right. We're going	
3	to move to Item 2.	
4	Welcome, Ms. Draper.	
5	MS. DRAPER: Good afternoon. Elisabeth Draper	
6	with staff. Item 2 is a petition from Florida	
7	Power & Light Company addressing the conversion of	
8	overhead distribution facilities to underground,	
9	and the contribution in aid of construction, or a	
10	CIC, an applicant has to pay FP&L for the	
11	conversion.	
12	Several cities expressed interest in	
13	underground conversions. And the current CIC	
14	formula is laid out in our rules and the FP&L's	
15	tariff. One component of the CIC calculation is	
16	the cost to remove the overhead facilities.	
17	FP&L is also currently storm hardening its	
18	overhead distribution facilities and projects that	
19	it will complete it's storm hardening within the	
20	next five to six years.	
21	Storm hardening includes the removal of	
22	overhead poles and lines; therefore, FP&L petition	
23	to revise its CIC formula, as shown in the proposed	
24	tariff, to exclude the removal cost of any	
25	non-hardened overhead facilities from the CIC	

1	calculation.
2	Staff recommends approval of FP&L's petition.
3	And Kevin Donaldson, for FP&L, and Schef Wright, on
4	behalf of two municipalities that are interested in
5	underground-ing, are present to answer any
6	questions you may have.
7	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you.
8	Mr. Donaldson, would you like to address the
9	Commission?
10	MR. DONALDSON: Madam Chairman, or former
11	Chairman, and Commissioner Graham new Commis
12	new Chairman Graham, we believe that this is a a
13	great opportunity for some of the municipalities to
14	take advantage of these underground conversion
15	projects. It will enable them to reduce some of
16	the costs that they would normally have to pay in
17	their construction in aid of contribution.
18	So, we're very happy to be able to present
19	this as a a means of allowing them to go ahead
20	and incentivize them to do this conversion project.
21	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you.
22	Mr. Wright.
23	MR. WRIGHT: Thank you, Commissioner,
24	Mr. Chairman, Commissioners. Schef Wright, Gardner
25	law firm, on behalf of Palm Beach and Long Boat Key

1	specifically. And y'all probably know I've been
2	working on this stuff for a while.
3	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Uh-huh.
4	MR. WRIGHT: I'm just here to support the
5	recommendation, to thank FPL for working with us on
6	getting these particular features of their
7	contribution in aid of construction tariff right.
8	It it correctly allocates costs where they
9	should be allocated and not where they shouldn't
10	and, in so doing, provides additional incentives
11	for underground-ing, which, as the staff had
12	pointed out in their recommendation, as FPL did in
13	their petition, is a good thing all around. It
14	enhances reliable service and provides many other
15	benefits.
16	So, we support the recommendation. Thanks
17	very much.
18	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Thank you. And there
19	seems to be a lot of support of this initiative
20	among the cities and the counties. So, kudos.
21	Commissioner Polmann.
22	COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Thank you, Madam
23	Chairman.
24	I appreciate staff explaining this to me in
25	briefing. I also appreciate FPL working with

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          municipalities on this. I'm -- I'm impressed by
