

Last month we bothered the Mayor, JEA Leadership, our City Councilmen, State Senator, and County Representative. All with no results. Can you help?


1. Literally HUNDREDS of tree limbs are leaning against overhead power cables on both sides of New Berlin Road, in multiple locations between the Dunn Creek Bridge and New Berlin Elementary School. The problem is most egregious between Lanier Road and Yellow Bluff Road. Below is a map

This **Third-World-like condition** has existed for several **years**. Please have a look at the attached photographs. The condition **already causes sporadic power outages** in the area. Power cables are **visibly stretched** and **under TENSION** from tree limbs sitting on top of them. This condition shows a lot of NEGLECT and will soon become a major power outage event. Hundreds of **neighborhood residents are at-risk for power failure!**

We've tried to get JEA to remove the vegetation. They seem to be too busy. Our local political representatives are unresponsive. Please do the right thing and arrange for the offending vegetation to be removed.
