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Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Seminole Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Seminole) requests confidential classification of certain information provided in Exh. No. AST-2 to direct testimony of Alan S. Taylor, filed contemporaneously with their petition for determination of need for Seminole Combined Cycle Facility, in the above referenced docket. Since the filing of their request, Seminole has filed Document No. 01042-2018, a notice of scrivener's error in Document No. 10830-2017 correcting the reference to Exh. AST-2 to Exh. AST-1, Document 2.

Seminole requests confidentiality of the highlighted information in Exh. AST-1, Document 2 under Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S.: "Information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms," and Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S.: "Information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information."

The highlighted information in Exh. AST-1, Document 2 for which confidential treatment is being sought can be described as the identities of the bidders who responded to Seminole's Request for Proposals for Firm Capacity and the sensitive pricing and site location information accompanying the bidder responses. Staff has reviewed the information Seminole filed as well as its confidentiality request and believes the information that is the subject of the request meets the criteria for confidentiality contained in Sections 366.093(3)(d) and 366.093(3)(e), F.S.
