FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S FIRST REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes ("Section 366.093"), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") hereby submits its First Request for Extension of Confidential Classification of information provided in response to AARP's Third Set of Interrogatories (No. 74), Office of Public Counsel's ("OPC") First Set of Interrogatories, (No. 3, Attachment 1) and OPC's Eighteenth Set of Interrogatories (No. 380); and FPL's Supplemental (Amended) response to Staff's First Set of Interrogatories (No. 37) ("Confidential Discovery Responses"). In support of this request, FPL states as follows:

- 1. On August 4, 2016, FPL filed a Request for Confidential Classification of the Confidential Discovery Responses, which included Exhibits A, B, C and D ("August 4, 2016 Request"). [Document Nos. 05883-16, 05884-16] By Order No. PSC-16-0331-CFO-EI, dated August 11, 2016 ("Order 0331"), the Commission granted FPL's August 4, 2016 Request. FPL adopts and incorporates by reference the August 4, 2016 and Order 0331.
- 2. The period of confidential treatment granted by Order 0331 will soon expire. The Confidential Discovery Responses that were the subject of FPL's August 4, 2016 Request and

Order 0331 warrant continued treatment as proprietary and confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3). Accordingly, FPL hereby submits its First Request for Extension of Confidential Classification.

- 3. All of the information designated in Exhibits A and B to the August 4, 2016 Request remain confidential. Accordingly, those exhibits will not be reproduced or reattached here. Regarding First Revised Exhibit C, all of the information listed in the August 4, 2016 Request remains confidential; the Exhibit is revised only to identify Meredith Quick as a new declarant.
- 4. Also included in support of this Request is First Revised Exhibit D, which consists of the declarations of Robert E. Barrett, Jr., Sam Forrest and Meredith Quick.
- 5. The Confidential Discovery Responses are intended to be and have been treated by FPL as private, its confidentiality has been maintained, and its disclosure would cause harm to FPL and its customers. Pursuant to Section 366.093, such materials are entitled to confidential treatment and are exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.
- 6. As described more fully in the declaration included as Exhibit D, the Confidential Discovery Response provided by FPL relate to information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of FPL to contract for goods or services on favorable terms. This information is protected by Section 366.093(3)(d), Fla. Stat.

7. Also, certain Confidential Discovery Responses relate to competitive interests, the

disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information.

This information is protected by Section 366.093(3)(e), Fla. Stat.

8. Upon a finding by the Commission that the Confidential Information remains

proprietary and confidential business information, the information should not be declassified for

at least an additional eighteen (18) month period and should be returned to FPL as soon as it is

no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. See § 366.093(4), Fla. Stat.

WHEREFORE, for the above and foregoing reasons, as more fully set forth in the

supporting materials and declarations included herewith, Florida Power & Light Company

respectfully requests that its First Request for Extension of Confidential Classification be

granted.
