Complaint: Other Complaint against Utilities, Inc. of Florida Details:

As I'm sure you know Public Utilities raised our rates substantially last Fall and despite many complaints as the rates were unreasonable and exorbitant they recently raised them again. Our typical bill used to run at or less than \$50. Our bill date 12/10/17 was \$147 for 20,800 gallons, 1/9/18 it was \$135 for 17,960 gallons and when we really cut back to the bare minimum for 2 people and used only 5,500 gallons the bill dated 2/8/18 was \$88.46 which is 1 1/2 times our previous bill with minimal consumption! Due to the high water base charges of \$27 for water base charge for water service and \$25 for wastewater service before we even use a drop of water the charges are more than we used to pay for all of our water. What, if anything are you all doing about these outrageous rates? This is very unfair to the people affected by these changes. I've checked and these rates are not in keeping with other companies bills. I look forward to your response. Susan Baum
