**Issue 1:** Should Indiantown's request for approval of tariffs to allow the gross-up of CIAC be approved? **Recommendation:** Yes, the revised tariff filed on March 29, 2018 should be approved. The utility should provide notice to all persons in the service areas included in the application who have filed a written request for service or who have been provided a written estimate for service within the 12 calendar months prior to the month the application was filed. The approved gross-up charges should be effective for connections made on or after the stamped approval date on the tariff sheets. The utility should provide proof of noticing within 10 days of rendering its approved notice.

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**Issue 2:** Should this docket be closed?

Recommendation: If a protest is filed by a substantially affected person within 21 days of issuance of the order, the revised tariff should remain in effect, with any revenues held subject to refund, pending resolution of the protest. If no timely protest is filed, the order should become final upon the issuance of a consummating order. However, the docket should remain open to allow staff to verify that the appropriate notice has been filed by the Utility and approved by staff. Once the utility has provided proof of noticing, the docket should be closed administratively.
