

A: We provide discounts, consolidation, a user friendly portal, a complete portfolio of services and a single point of contact for our customers. With time we are providing more and more advanced services.

9. Other than Special Access/Business Data Services pricing, what are CLECs' main issues/challenges today?

A: Many competitors face challenges in obtaining wholesale access to network facilities at reasonable rates. In some recent cases, wholesale providers have proposed significant price increases to wholesale services offered under commercial contracts.

Additionally, ILEC copper loop facilities are often used by competitors to provide business customers with cost-effective options for both voice and broadband needs. Where ILEC copper loops are retired, competitors face challenges in obtaining alternative loop facilities at competitive rate.

10. What decisions have the FCC and/or states made since the 1996 Federal Telecom Act that affected your company the most (good or bad)?

A: MetTel and similar competitors were negatively impacted by FCC decisions that eliminated access to UNE-P and unbundled network elements.

A: Major decisions are expected to address network deployment (including 5G networks), competitor access to fiber, intercarrier compensation reforms, Connect America Fund/Universal Service Fund reforms, and regulatory treatment of Internet access services.
