Robert,

The reservation capacity of 3 mgd in the Leesburg Turnpike WWTP is the reservation quantity that was available. The combination of the cost of the capacity purchase from Leesburg and the bulk cost for treatment was significantly less than the cost for SSU to construct and operate a WWTP with a maximum month average day capacity of approximately 1 mgd. Therefore, the least cost option to SSU was to accept the offer from Leesburg to purchase 3 mgd. So, SSU basically obtained 3 mgd of wastewater capacity for less than it would have paid to build a 1 mgd plant. I believe the reason Leesburg sold the capacity at such a good price was that it had built capacity during the real estate boom, and with the real estate bust probably realizes it will never use all of that capacity. So in that respect, it was a good deal for the Leesburg as well. The proverbial "win-win".

There are two columns of values on Schedule 1. One is titled "12/31/2022 - 100%", and the other is titled "12/31/2021 - 80%".

The constructed cost (Utility Plant in Service) is the same in both columns, and is the number(s) Robert has stated. This is because it will be fully constructed by the time it serving 80% of its capacity.

What is different between the 80% vs 100% is all the other rows impacting rate base.

Although I expect SSU will file a territory amendment within the next 6 months, the estimate of about 7,800 residential units speculative. Such an expansion would require an expansion of the WTP and increases in other costs as well so I do not think at this time it should have any consideration in the current revenue requirement.
