Florida Public Utilities Company and Florida Public Utilities Company-Fort Meade (herein “FPUC” or “the Company”) hereby files its petition for approval of its final purchased gas true-up amount related to the twelve-month period ended December 31, 2017. In support of this Petition, FPUC states:

3. Pursuant to the requirements in this docket, FPUC, concurrently with the filing of this petition, files the testimony of Mr. Geoffrey Alexander Wight, along with Schedule A-7 (Exhibit GAW-1) for its consolidated gas division for the period January 2017 through December 2017.
4. As indicated in the testimony of Mr. Wight’s, FPUC’s final true-up amount for the period January 2017 through December 2017, including interest, net of estimated true-up for the same period, is an over-recovery of \$217,551. This reflects the difference between the

Company's actual over-recovery of \$896,689, for the period as compared to its estimated over-recovery of \$679,138 for the same period, which was based on six months of actual and six months of estimated data.

WHEREFORE, FPUC respectfully requests that the Commission enter its Order approving the Company's final true up amount for the period January 2017 through December 2017.

5 A. I am employed by Florida Public Utilities Company as a Senior
6 Regulatory Analyst.

7 Q. What is the purpose of your testimony at this time?

8 A. To advise the Commission of the actual over/under recovery of the
9 Purchased Gas Adjustment for the period January 1, 2017 through
10 December 31, 2017, as compared to the true-up amount previously
11 reported for that period which was based on six months actual and
12 six months estimated.

13 Q. Please state the actual amount of over/under recovery of the
14 Purchased Gas Adjustment for January 1, 2017 through December
15 31, 2017.

16 A. During January 2017 through December 2017, FPUC over-
17 recovered \$896,689.

1 Q. How does this amount compare with the estimated true-up amount,
2 which was allowed by the Commission during the November 2017
3 hearing?

4 A. As recognized in Order No. PSC-2017-0419-FOF-GU, in Docket
5 No. 20170003-GU, FPUC had an anticipated over-recovery of
6 \$679,138, based upon six months of actual and six months of
7 projected data.

8 Q. Have you prepared any exhibits at this time?

9 A. We prepared and pre-filed composite Exhibit GAW-1, containing
10 Schedule A-7, Final PGA Over/Under Recovery for the Period
11 January 2017 through December 2017.

12 Q. Does this conclude your testimony?

13 A. Yes.
