2	CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. Staff, Item No. 6.
3	MR. BUYS: Good morning, Commissioners. I am
4	Dale Buys with Commission staff.
5	If I may, Mr. Chairman, I would like to
6	introduce to you our newest staff member, Mr. John
7	Hightower. He joined the Commission staff in
8	January of this year. He is our newest member of
9	the finance and tax team in the Division of
10	Accounting and Finance. And with that, he is going
11	to introduce Item 6.
12	CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Mr. Hightower.
13	MR. HIGHTOWER: Good morning, Commissioners.
14	I am John Hightower with Commission staff.
15	Item No. 6 addresses Florida Power & Light's
16	request for approval to change its AFUDC rate from
17	6.16 percent to 5.97 percent effective January 1st,
18	2018, in Docket No. 20180038-EI.
19	Staff has reviewed the company's filing and
20	believes that FP&L's requested rate is appropriate,
21	consistent with Rule 25-60141, Florida
22	Administrative Code, and recommends that it be
23	approved.
24	Staff is prepared to answer any questions the
25	Commission may have on this matter.

1	CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Thank you.
2	Commissioners, any questions of Mr. Hightower?
3	Commissioner Polmann.
4	COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Thank you, Mr.
5	Chairman.
6	Mr. Hightower, is this your first opportunity
7	before the Commission?
8	MR. HIGHTOWER: Yes, sir.
9	COMMISSIONER POLMANN: I have had occasion in
10	my readings of various items in a field such as
11	yours, not being very familiar with certain items
12	in your field, that percentages sometimes are
13	counterintuitive, where a percentage that goes down
14	is not necessarily a decrease in the cost to the
15	customer. And, in fact, I think I have seen cases
16	where a decrease has actually caused an increase,
17	so I may be wrong on that. But could you explain
18	to me whether this decrease in percentage is
19	actually a decrease in the cost?
20	MR. HIGHTOWER: A decrease in the percentage
21	is actually a decrease in the cost. Yeah, I would
22	say it is in this matter. They will collect
23	less less for the less of the AFUDC, you
24	know, from the customer.
25	COMMISSIONER POLMANN: So it's affirmative

1	MR. HIGHTOWER: Yes.
2	COMMISSIONER POLMANN: it's a lesser cost
3	to the customer?
4	MR. HIGHTOWER: Yes, sir. It's less.
5	COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Okay. Well, thank you
6	very.

8	COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Mr. Chairman, I would
