CUSTOMER SERVICE HEARING

Customers will be given the opportunity to present testimony during the evening session beginning at 6:00 p.m., on Tuesday, May 15, 2018, and the morning session beginning at 9:30 a.m., on Wednesday May 16, 2018. Customers' testimony will be subject to cross-examination and will be a part of the evidence presented in the formal hearing.

All customers wishing to testify are urged to be present at the beginning of the session since the session may be adjourned early if no customers are present.

PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE

The purpose of the customer service and technical hearing shall be to take testimony, including customer testimony, on the Utility's application for increase in wastewater rates in Monroe County. The procedure at these hearings shall be as follows: Any pending motions will first be addressed at the technical hearing, commencing at 9:30 a.m. on May 15, 2018, and then all parties shall be given the opportunity to present testimony and other evidence on issues identified at the prehearing conference held on May 1, 2018. At the customer service hearing beginning at 6:00 p.m., on May 15, 2018, and the morning session beginning at 9:30 a.m., on Wednesday May 16, 2018, members of the public may present testimony on the issues identified by the parties at the prehearing conference. At the conclusion of the customers' testimony, the technical hearing will resume. All witnesses shall be subject to cross examination at the conclusion of their testimony.

JURISDICTION

Jurisdiction over this Utility is vested in the Commission by Chapter 367, Florida Statutes. Authority to approve increased rates is governed by Sections 367.081, 367.082, 367.101, and 367.171, Florida Statutes. The provisions of Chapters 25-9, 25-22, 25-30, and 28-106, Florida Administrative Code, are also applicable.
