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1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Let's move on to Item No. 9.

3 MR. WRIGHT: Good morning, Commissioners.

4 Doug Wright with Commission staff.

5 Items No. 9 to 13 are petitions by Duke Energy
6 Florida, LLC, Gulf Power Company, Tampa Electric
7 Company, Florida Power & Light Company, and Florida
8 Public Utilities Company, respectively, for the
9 approval of their standard offer contracts and
10 associated rate schedules.

11 Section 366.913, Florida Statutes, requires
12 that each investor-owned utility continuously offer
13 to purchase capacity and energy from renewable-
14 energy generators and small, qualifying facilities.

15 Commission Rules 25-17.200 through 25-17.310,
16 Florida Administrative Code, implement the statutes
17 and require each IOU to file with the Commission a
18 standard offer contract based on the next avoidable
19 fossil-fuel generating unit of each technology type
20 identified in the utility's current ten-year site
21 plan.

22 These petitions are in pursuit of those rules.
23 Generally, this year's revisions to the standard
24 offer contracts and their associated rate sched- --
25 rate schedules include updated avoided unit

1 specifications, calendar dates, and payment
2 examples as well as typographical corrections and
3 updates to names or position titles.

4 Staff notes that our recommendation for
5 Item 9, Duke's petition, has one oral modification.
6 On May 25th, 2018, Duke filed a revised tariff
7 sheet, No. 9.458, to reflect the updated delivery
8 voltage adjustment factors.

9 This revised tariff sheet replaces Page 59 of
10 71 of Attachment A to the recommendation, also
11 numbered Page 65 of the recommendation, itself.
12 This revision also necessitates minor modifications
13 of dates and references throughout the
14 recommendation, itself.

15 As such, staff recommends -- requests
16 administrative authority to make the necessary
17 changes in the recommendation to reflect the
18 updated filing.

19 Staff and the utilities are available for any
20 questions.

21 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Thank you, staff.

22 Commissioners, any questions of staff on --
23 specifically, let's deal with Item No. 9.

24 Seeing none, I'll entertain a motion.

25 COMMISSIONER POLMANN: I understand,

1 Mr. Chairman, staff suggested we take Items 9
2 through 13 simultaneously. Is -- is that your
3 intent?

4 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: I was just going to take 9
5 and then we'll take 10 through 13.

6 COMMISSIONER POLMANN: I would move approval
7 of the Item No. 9, inclusive of the or- -- oral
8 modification, as Mr. Wright has indicated, and all
9 issues, including the administrative authority
10 requested.

11 COMMISSIONER BROWN: Second.

12 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It's been moved and second,
13 for Item No. 9. Any further discussion?

14 Seeing none, all in favor, say aye.

15 (Chorus of ayes.)

16 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Any opposed?

17 By your action, you have approved Item No. 9.

18 Okay. Mr. Polmann -- Commissioner Polmann?

19 COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Mr. Chairman, I would
20 move Items 10 through 13, all issues, staff
21 recommendation for approval.

22 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Is there a second?

23 COMMISSIONER BROWN: Second.

24 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It's been moved and second,
25 staff recommendations on Items 10 through 13, of
