3	Item No. 8. We're coming back to seven later.
4	Welcome.
5	MR. MERRYDAY: Good morning, Commissioners.
6	I'm Henry Merryday with Commission staff.
7	Item 8 is a petition from Duke Energy Florida
8	for approval of a smart meter opt-out tariff. The
9	opt-out tariff gives customers the option to
10	receive a non-communicating meter in lieu of the
11	utility's new standard smart meter.
12	Customers will pay a one-time enrollment fee
13	of \$96.34, and a monthly surcharge of \$15.60.
14	These fees reflect Duke's inter incremental
15	costs to offer the opt-out tariff. Duke predicts
16	about 2700 out of 1.8 million customers will
17	participate.
18	The Commission approved a similar opt-out
19	tariff for FPL in 2015. Staff did not receive any
20	customer comments regarding this docket. Based on
21	the cost support provided in responses and
22	responses to data requests, staff recommends
23	approval of Duke's petition.
24	CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Thank you, staff.
25	Commissioners, any questions of staff? If

1	not, I'll entertain a motion.
2	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Mr. Chairman, this is
3	consistent with our prior ruling. And with that, I
4	would move staff recommendation on all issues.
