## QUESTION:

In Docket No. 20170123-EI, FPL agreed to commence amortization of the costs associated with the St. Johns River Power Park (SJRPP) during the term of its current settlement agreement. Please identify within the Settlement Agreement, the language that permits FPL to defer amortizing the regulatory assets associated with the early retirement of Martin Units 1 and 2 and Lauderdale Units 4 and 5.

## **RESPONSE:**

The question correctly notes that in Docket No. 20170123-EI, FPL agreed to commence amortization of the costs associated with the St. Johns River Power Park (SJRPP) during the term of its current Settlement Agreement. The Agreement does not prohibit FPL from deferring the amortization of the regulatory assets associated with the early retirement of Martin Units 1 and 2 and Lauderdale Units 4 and 5. As noted on pages 5 and 6 of FPL's Petition, FPL's proposed creation of a regulatory asset associated with these generation units is consistent with the Commission's approval of Gulf Power's request to create a regulatory asset and defer amortization of Plant Smith Units 1 and 2. See Order No. PSC-2016-0361-PAA-EI (the "Plant Smith Order"). The base rate settlement agreement approved for Gulf Power in Order No. PSC-17-0178-S-EI and discussed in the Plant Smith Order as well as the settlement agreement approved in FPL's most recent rate case contain almost identical depreciation and amortization provisions pertinent to this issue. Under both agreements, depreciation and amortization rates remain in effect until reset in a future rate proceeding; therefore, the agreements prohibit a request for a new amortization rate prior to termination. In the Plant Smith Order, the Commission considered these specific depreciation and amortization settlement agreement provisions in determining that the creation of a regulatory asset did not involve deferral of costs that otherwise would be recovered (in part) during the term of the Gulf Settlement Agreement and that it was appropriate to defer recovery until an amortization rate could be established. The same conclusions on the part of the Commission should apply to FPL under its current Commission-approved settlement agreement.

Further, the proposed retirements of the Lauderdale and Martin units are accompanied by replacement generation that will be constructed and, in the case of the Martin replacement, operating during the time period governed by the Settlement Agreement. These replacement units/upgrades to existing units will result in cost savings for FPL's customers, and FPL will not be recovering the replacement costs during the Settlement Agreement time period.

FPL's agreement in Docket No. 20170123-EI to amortization of the costs of the SJRPP assets (in part) during the term of the current Settlement Agreement is distinguishable from the instant case and was the result of a multi-faceted, comprehensive settlement based on the specific facts of the SJRPP shutdown, which involved termination of a power purchase agreement and a joint operating agreement among other matters. See Order No. PSC-2017-0415-AS-EI.
