6. Circumstances of Discontinuance.

The Affected Services are provided to the customer' locations via TDM facilities obtained from Sprint that are being decommissioned. The discontinuance will affect one-hundred and eight (108) business customers located across the areas listed above. Windstream will assist the affected customers in migrating their services to Windstream's supported platform or by upgrading to one of our more robust unified communications products. Alternatively, the affected customers can obtain service from an alternative service provider. Windstream is affirmatively contacting all of the affected customers in addition to the notice letter (Attachment 1).

7. Conclusion

Windstream believes that the proposed discontinuance is reasonable and necessary. As outlined herein, Windstream will take reasonable steps, to the extent that it is able, to assure that the discontinuance of this service is not unduly disruptive to the present or future public convenience and necessity. The affected customers will not be unduly harmed because they are being offered alternative services to the those being discontinued, and/or have the option to move service to an alternative provider serving these locations.

Accordingly, Windstream respectfully requests that the Commission permit it to discontinue the provision of the Affected Services as outlined herein, pursuant to Section 63.71.
