## **QUESTION**:

Please provide the dollar amounts based on gross annual income associated with the following percentages:

- a. 0.175% in 2020;
- b. 0.2% in 2021;
- c. 0.225% in 2022; and
- d. 0.25% in 2023.

## RESPONSE:

The dollar amounts below are based on a Jurisdictional per Books Operating Revenue of \$10.9 billion, as projected in FPL's 2018 Forecasted Earnings Surveillance Report (FESR) publicly filed with the Commission in March 2018:

- a. 0.175% in 2020 = \$18.1 Million
- b. 0.200% in 2021 = \$20.6 Million
- c. 0.225% in 2022 = \$23.2 Million
- d. 0.250% in 2023 = \$25.8 Million
