Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Orlando Utilities Commission (Petitioner), requests confidential classification of certain information provided in response to the Southern Alliance for Clean Energy's First Request for Production of Documents (PODs), this information is also being provided to the Commission pursuant to Order No. PSC-2019-0062-PCO-EG.

The Petitioner requests confidentiality under Section 366.093(3)(a), F.S., "trade secrets," and Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S., "Information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information."
