Dear Commission Clerk,

Raintree Waterworks, Inc. (Raintree or Utility) hereby submits its application for a Limited Alternative Rate Increase in Lake County pursuant to Rule No. 25-30.457, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).

In support of its petition thereof, Raintree Waterworks states the following:

Pursuant to Rule 25-30.457, F.A.C., as an alternative to a rate case, a Class C utility may petition the Commission for a limited alternative rate increase of up to 20 percent of service revenues. This rule was designed to streamline the rate increase process for qualifying small water or wastewater companies, by establishing an abbreviated procedure for a limited rate increase that is less time consuming and thus less costly for the utilities, customers, and Commission staff. This rule is similar to the rules governing price index and pass-through increases, in that an engineering or financial audit of the utility's books and records is not required.

The rule was adopted by the Commission on March 15, 2005. The Commission has previously approved such in the following Orders:

- 8) Said SARC Order established the Utility's rate base, capital structure, annual operating expenses and revenues and was issued with the 7-year period prior to petition.

Petitioner's Schedules and Additional Information

Attached hereto are the following required schedules:

- (a) Annualized revenues by customer class and meter size for the most recent 12-month period using the rates in effect at the time the utility files its petition. For the purposes of this calculation the calendar year 2018 was utilized to be consistent with the most recent index filing.
- (b) Current and proposed rates for all classes of customers utilizing 20 percent of the annualized water service revenue.
- (c) Additional informational schedule showing most recent 12-month Operating Expenses.

As further information, Raintree recently replace seventy-five (75) non-operational meters due to the age and condition. These meters had registered over one million (1,000,000) gallons. The total cost of this meter replacement was \$9,865. Further, the utility is also replacing a hydropneumatic tank due to its deteriorated condition and age. The approximately estimated cost is between \$55,000 to \$60,000 for this replacement. This project is currently in process.

Petitioner's Statements

Raintree Waterworks through the undersigned representative hereby states that the figures and calculations upon which the change in rates is based are accurate.

Raintree Waterworks further states that the change in rates will not cause the Utility to exceed the top of the range of its last authorized rate of return on equity, with a range of 7.94 percent to 10.74 percent as established by Order No. PSC-16-0256-PAA-WU, issued June 30, 2016.

Filing Fee

The total filing fee in the amount of \$500 is also attached to this LARI petition pursuant to Rule 25-30.30.020(2)(f), Florida Administrative Code.

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WHERFORE, the Utility respectfully requests that the Commission:

- A. Accept jurisdiction of this Petition and utilize the procedure set forth in Rule 25-30.457, F.A.C;
- B. Evaluate the petition and determine the petitioner's eligibility for a limited alternative rate increase within 30 days of receipt of said petition.
- C. Notify the petitioner in writing as to whether the petition is accepted or denied.
- D. Approve final rates as requested herein within 90 days from the official filing date as established by Rule 25-30.457(4), F.A.C.;
