1 PROCEEDINGS 2 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. To the bottom of the 3 agenda. Item No. 7. 4 MR. MCNULTY: Good morning, Commissioners. 5 I'd like to take this opportunity to introduce a new staff member, Aaron Reda. 6 Aaron is a recent 7 graduate of Florida A&M University's Master's in Business Administration. He started with us in 8 9 January and he'll be introducing this item. 10 MR. REDA: Good morning, Commissioners. I am 11 Aaron Reda with PSC staff. Item 7 addresses Duke 12 Energy Florida's motion to -- for approval to 13 reallocate its electrical vehicle charging station 14 piolet segments, identified in its 2017 second 15 revised and restated settlement agreement in the 16 2017 settlement agreement, specified in electrical 17 vehicle charging station allocation of four 18 different consumer segments that include multiple 19 unit dwellings, work places, public spaces and DC 20 fast-charging depos. 21 In its motion, Duke Energy Florida states it's 22 become necessary to reallocate a portion of its 23 proposed electrical vehicle charging stations from multiple-unit dwellings to other segments. 24 Based 25 on the information at hand, the staff recommends

Signatories to the original 3 settlement have expressed to Duke Energy Florida 4 either no objection or no position to the motion. 5 Staff is prepared to answer any questions you 6 may have. And thank you, again, Commissioners. 7 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Mr. Reda, do you know 8 that -- do you own a bow tie? 9 MR. REDA: Pardon? 10 CHAIRMAN BROWN: Do you own a bow tie? 11 MR.
