On July 12, 2019, Carla Smalley called to give a status update on getting the territory systems maps produced, along with the territory description, for the Lake Talquin Water Company system in Leon County. The Florida Rural Water Association (FRWA) has been assisting the Utility in producing these documents. Jim Casno, FRWA, explained that he has completed the on-site work necessary to produce the maps and legal description.
