Details:

I am concerned that the water utility company serving my community, Swiss Golf and Tennis, is requesting a water/sewer rate increase to pay for "replacing old water meters" per a letter from the company. This meter replacement seems to me to be a normal maintenance cost. I pay monthly land rent, which was raised signifying January 2019, which should be used in part to maintain the community, i.e. water meter replacement. In addition, I am very unhappy about a raise in the water/sewer rate due to the fact that the water in my home has been undrinkable for more

than 4 weeks due to extreme sulfur smell and gray water. Why should I pay more for water I cannot drink. Thank you for your consideration.
