

**TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S FINAL
STATUS REPORT ON TEMPORARY SERVICE**

Tampa Electric Company reports as follows regarding the status of its provision of temporary retail electric service to a mining facility located in the service area of a neighboring utility:

1. On October 9, 2017, the Commission entered its Order No. PSC-2017-0385-PAA-EI ("Order No. 2017-0385") in Docket No. 20170181-EI, approving Tampa Electric's request for temporary territorial variance, to enable Tampa Electric to provide retail electric service on a temporary basis to Mosaic Fertilizer, LLC (Mosaic) Peacock mining facility outside Tampa Electric's approved service territory.

2. As stated in Order No. 2017-0385, Tampa Electric's retail electric service to the Mosaic facility is temporary in nature, with Mosaic having indicated to Tampa Electric that such service will be needed until such time as Duke Energy Florida LLC ("DEF") can complete construction of a 230 kV transmission line and substation needed in order to enable DEF to commence providing service to Mosaic's mining facility.

3. The construction work required to enable DEF to commence providing electric service to Mosaic's mining facility has been completed, DEF has taken over permanent electric service to the facility, and Tampa Electric's temporary service to the facility has ended.


4. In view of the foregoing, this is Tampa Electric's final status report in connection with this matter.

5. This final status report requires no action by the Commission, as Docket No. 2017-0181-EI was closed consistent with the Consummating Order in that docket, Order No. PSC-2017-0421-CO-EI, issued November 6, 2017.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric submits this its final status report regarding its continuing provision of temporary retail electric service to Mosaic's Peacock mining facility.
