1 PROCEEDINGS 2 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. On to the last item 3 on the agenda, No. 12. 4 MR. SIBLEY: Good morning. I am Matthew 5 Sibley, speaking on behalf of Commission staff. Item No. 12 addresses Lakeside Waterworks, Inc.'s, 6 7 application for a limited alternative rate case in 8 Lake County. The utility is a Class C utility 9 providing water and wastewater service to 10 approximately 183 customers. 11 Staff has determined that the utility has met 12 the eligibility requirement for the limited 13 alternative rate case under Rule 25-30.457. The 14 rule allows for the eligible utility to apply for 15 an increase in rates no greater than 20 percent. 16 A customer meeting was held and one customer 17 complaint has been received since the meeting 18 concluded. 19 A representative of OPC and the utility are 20 present. OPC would like to address Item No. 12. 21 Staff is prepared to answer any questions at this 22 time. 23 Thank you, staff. CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: 24 OPC. 25 Yes, thank you. Tad David for the MR. DAVID:

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1 Office of Public Counsel. Again, thank you this 2 morning. 3 OPC does not object to or oppose the recommended rate increase in this docket. 4 T would 5 just like to note our objection to the current procedure and language of the limited alternative 6 7 rate increase. I'll also note, once again, on this record, 8 9 the amendments to all of the rules related to the 10 LARI procedures are currently in the rule-11 development process and, hopefully, the resulting 12 provisions will address all of our -- all of OPC's 13 concerns. And that being said, once again, we're 14 not going to oppose the recommendation in this 15 particular docket. 16 Thank you. 17 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. Mr. Rendell? 18 MR. RENDELL: Good morning, Commissioners. 19 Troy Rendell on behalf of Lakeside. I'm here 20 basically to answer questions and support staff's 21 recommendation. 22 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. Commissioners. 23 Commissioner Brown. 24 COMMISSIONER BROWN: I kind of share probably 25 similar concerns with the current LARI rule. So.

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I'm happy to see that it is in rulemaking and look
forward to seeing what the provisions are. I don't
like the way the rule is, quite frankly. It's very
vague.
Troy, what is the 20-percent increase going to

Troy, what is the 20-percent increase going to be used for? I'm curious.

7 It's stated in staff's MR. RENDELL: 8 recommendation, the current -- utility is currently 9 earning like 2-percent rate of return. There's 10 been significant improvements made to the system. 11 And the last staff-assisted rate case, in 12 response to staff's -- customers' comments at the 13 customer meeting, we did make improvements to some 14 high-service pumps. We had indicated at that time 15 we'd probably be coming in for a limited proceeding 16 for those items, but we did not. We elected not 17 to. 18 So, it was really to cover the -- the increase 19 in the capital expenditures that -- that's occurred 20 since the last staff-assisted rate case. 21 Thank you. COMMISSIONER BROWN: That's all. 22 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Anv --23 COMMISSIONER BROWN: I would move -- move 24 approval of all issues in this item. 25 COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Second.

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1 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It's been moved and second, 2 staff recommendation on Item No. 12. Any further 3 discussion? 4 Seeing none, all in favor, say aye. 5 (Chorus of ayes.) 6 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Any opposed? 7 By your action, you have approved staff rec on that item. 8 9 A couple of things, No. 1 -- I failed to 10 mention this earlier -- the memorial service for 11 Ruth is going to be tomorrow at 3:00 at Culley --12 COMMISSIONER BROWN: Today --13 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Today -- sorry. Today at 14 3:00, at Culley Meadowood's funeral home. I failed to mention -- I want to thank J.R. 15 16 and OPC for what they've done for us -- to me --17 (laughter) -- for this -- the last two years, this 18 term. 19 Now, J.R. and I've got a great relationship. 20 He's got a role. We all have a role here. And 21 thank you very much for -- I'm a huge proponent of 22 stipulations and settlements. And when -- when you 23 quys do that and you quys come together, as I say, 24 and sing Kumbaya, I think it's fantastic. And my 25 hat goes off to you. You do a dil- -- a dil- -- a

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1 very diligent job and you stay on a professional 2 level and I appreciate all you've done for us. 3 I want to thank both Mary Anne and Keith 4 because they have my back, day in and day out, when 5 I'm fighting J.R. and when I'm fighting the -- and I'm fighting the utilities. So, I appreciate you 6 7 guys always being there with me. 8 I failed to mention, state of Florida being the third-largest state in the United States, and 9 10 we have one of our Commissioners now on the exec 11 board for NARUC, which is Julie Brown. 12 Congratulations to Julie Brown. 13 (Applause.) 14 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: We need and deserve to have 15 somebody at the table when those things -- the 16 decisions are made and the debates are happening 17 and I -- I think we couldn't have picked a better 18 person for that. And so, thank you for that. 19 And this being my last agenda meeting, I am 20 ready to hand this off to somebody. 21 Commissioner Clark, you can adjourn us. 22 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Thank you, very much. 23 Mr. Chairman. Appreciate you. 24 Feels different over here. WOW. 25 (Laughter.)

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1 Again, I -- I wanted to COMMISSIONER CLARK: 2 say thank you to Chairman Graham for the 3 outstanding leadership, the outstanding work that 4 he's done, and to the staff for the support they've 5 Thank you to my colleagues for your given. support, for your confidence in me. 6 7 My commitment is to you -- to you is to do my absolute best to make sure that we move this 8 9 organization forward in a positive and -- and true 10 direction. 11 So, with that, we stand adjourned today. 12 Thank you. 13 (Agenda item concluded.) 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25
