The managerial and technical abilities of the Applicant's key personnel are as follows:

Thomas Rutledge, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer

Thomas M. Rutledge is the Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Charter Communications, Inc., the second-largest cable company in the United States, with more than 91,000 employees and 26 million customers across 41 states.

Prior to becoming CEO of Charter in 2012, Mr. Rutledge, a 40-year veteran of the industry, served as Chief Operating Officer of Cablevision Systems. He began his career in 1977 at American Television and Communications (ATC), a predecessor of Time Warner Cable where he served in many different capacities, eventually becoming President of Time Warner Cable.

Mr. Rutledge is the current Chairman of the National Cable and Telecommunications Association (NCTA) and serves on the boards of CableLabs and C-SPAN. In 2011, he received NCTA's Vanguard Award for Distinguished Leadership, the cable industry's highest honor, and is a member of the Cable Hall of Fame and the Broadcasting and Cable Hall of Fame.

He received a B.A. in economics from California University in California, Pennsylvania in 1977.

John Bickham, President and Chief Operating Officer

John Bickham is President and Chief Operating Officer at Charter Communications, Inc. Mr. Bickham joined Charter as Executive Vice President and COO in 2012. Mr. Bickham's operational expertise has helped Charter navigate substantial growth in recent years as the fastest growing cable company in the nation. He was named President in July 2016 when transactions with Time Warner Cable and Bright House Networks closed.

Mr. Bickham joined Charter from Cablevision Systems Corporation (currently part of Altice USA), where he served as President of Cable and Communications. Earlier in his career, Mr. Bickham was Executive Vice President for Time Warner Cable with corporate responsibility for several large markets. Mr. Bickham was a founding executive of KBLCOM in 1986, a cable company that partnered with American Television and Communications, a predecessor company of Time Warner Cable.

Mr. Bickham served on the Cable Center Board and was honored with the industry's Vanguard Award for Cable Operations Management in 2007.

He received a B.S. in electrical engineering from Texas A&I, now known as Texas A&M-Kingsville.

Christopher Winfrey, Chief Financial Officer

Christopher L. Winfrey joined Charter Communications, Inc. as Chief Financial Officer in 2010. Mr. Winfrey is responsible for Charter's accounting, financial planning and analysis, tax and treasury functions, as well as mergers and acquisitions, capital structure activities and investor relations.

Mr. Winfrey joined Charter from Unitymedia GmbH, Germany's second-largest cable operator, where he served as Chief Financial Officer, and separately as Managing Director for Unitymedia's cable operations, broadcasting and satellite entities.

Earlier in his career, Mr. Winfrey served as Senior Vice President, Corporate Finance and Development at Cablecom, GmbH for three years. He was also Director of Financial Planning and

Analysis of NTL Incorporated's continental European operations, and a senior associate in the private equity group at Communications Equity Associates.

Mr. Winfrey has spent nearly 20 years in the cable industry, and in 2015 received The Internet & Television Association's (NCTA) Vanguard Award for Young Leadership. He currently serves on the board of directors for the Greenwich Center for Hope and Renewal.

He received a B.S. in accounting and an MBA from the University of Florida.

Richard Dykhouse, Executive Vice President, General Counsel and Corporate Secretary

Richard R. Dykhouse is Executive Vice President, General Counsel and Corporate Secretary at Charter Communications, Inc. Mr. Dykhouse joined Charter as Vice President, Associate General Counsel and Assistant Secretary in 2006.

Mr. Dykhouse joined Charter from CNH Global, N.V. (now CNH Industrial), where he served as Senior Counsel and Assistant Secretary. Before CNH, he was an attorney for Consec, Inc. (now CNO Financial Group, Inc.) for nearly 10 years, serving in the corporate law group, with his last position as Senior Vice President, Legal.

He received a B.S. in finance from Olivet Nazarene University, an MBA from Indiana University and a Juris Doctor from Indiana University Robert H. McKinney School of Law.
