Please refer to TECO's Shared Solar Report, filed with the Commission on March 2, 2020.

- 1.** What portion of the 17.5 MW total demand of the Lake Hancock site was subscribed at the time of the Shared Solar Report?
 - A.** On 12/31/2019, 2.978 MW total demand was subscribed. This figure was derived by using $6,731,244 \text{ kWh subscribed} / (8760 * .258)$, where 8760 is the amount of hours in a year and 25.8% is the capacity factor of the Lake Hancock site. This means that the portion subscribed is: $2.978 / 17.500 = 17.02\%$.

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- 2.** Please break down the 2019 SSR-1 Tariff costs by type (unit cost, administration, etc.).
 - A.** Once the program was live, O&M costs were \$2,870.94. Contractor marketing charges were \$2,790.94 and \$80.00 was printing costs for marketing materials.

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- 3.** Staff assumes that 2019 energy sales under TECO's Shared Solar Tariff were 555,015 kWh (\$34,966.55 / \$0.063). Is this correct?
 - A.** Yes, this is correct. Specifically, billed kWh for commercial customers was 38,583 kWh and billed kWh for residential customers was 516,435 for a total of 555,015 kWh.
