**GULF POWER COMPANY'S
NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code ("F.A.C."), Gulf Power Company ("Gulf") files this Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification ("Notice"). This Notice relates to confidential information that Gulf will produce to the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC") in response to OPC's Fourth Set of Interrogatories (Nos. 89-90). On January 7, 2020, as modified on February 6, 2020, the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued an Order Establishing Procedure in this docket requiring that copies of discovery requests and responses shall be served on all parties and the Commission staff. In compliance with that directive, Gulf will produce to all parties and the Commission staff copies of Gulf's responses to OPC's Fourth Set of Interrogatories, including confidential information that is protected from public disclosure under Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C., Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and other Florida laws. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a) and (d), Gulf requests confidential handling of the answers, responses and/or responsive documents that are identified as confidential in Gulf's responses. Gulf will file all requisite Requests for Confidential Classification specifying those portions of the referenced answers, responses and/or responsive documents which Gulf asserts are entitled to confidential treatment within 21 days, as provided by Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C.
