Staff has completed its initial review of your application and has determined that Lake Yale Utilities, LCC is eligible for a staff-assisted rate case. The filing fee for this rate case is \$1,500 based on the capacity of the Utility's systems as provided by Section 367.145(2), Florida Statutes and Rule 25-30.020(2)(f), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The filing fee must be received by **August 12, 2020**, which would be the official filing date for this rate case. **Pursuant to Rule 25-30.455(8), F.A.C., the Commission will deny the application if the utility does not remit the filing fee within 30 days after official acceptance.**
