Lake Talquin Water Company, Inc. filed its application for a grandfather water certificate in Leon County on November 30, 2017. During the pendency of the proceedings, Lake Talquin sold the utility to Lake Talquin Waterworks, Inc. The purchaser has filed a new application for a grandfather certificate, which will be addressed in Docket No. 20200195-WU, In re: Application of Lake Talquin Waterworks, Inc. for grandfather water certificate in Leon County and pass through of regulatory assessment fees.

On August 12, 2020, Lake Talquin Water Company, Inc. filed a request that its application filed in Docket No. 20170253-WU be withdrawn, and stated it was not seeking the refund of its filing fee. Staff has determined that due to the newly-opened docket, there are no pending issues that need to be addressed by the Commission regarding the application in Docket No. 20170253-WU. Pursuant to Section 2.07 C.2.d(4), of the Administrative Procedures Manual, staff may administratively close dockets in which the applicant seeks to withdraw its initial pleading, there are no pending issues that need to be addressed by the Commission, and no request for refund of the filing fee has been made.
