By Order No. PSC-2020-0267-PAA-WS, issued July 27, 2020, in Docket No. 20190195-WS, the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) approved the transfer of Regency Utilities, Inc.'s (Regency) water and wastewater systems and Certificate Nos. 641-W and 551-S to Duval Waterworks, Inc. (utility). The monthly water and wastewater rates you were paying to Regency will remain unchanged unless and until a change is approved by the Commission. However, Commission approved an increase in the late payment charge and the addition of non-sufficient funds charges (NSF) for the utility. The new late payment charge and NSF charges are set forth below.

**Approved Late Payment Charge**  
\$6.50

**Approved NSF Charges**

Pursuant to Section 68.065(2), Florida Statutes

- (1) \$25, if the face value does not exceed \$50;
- (2) \$30, if the face value exceeds \$50 but does not exceed \$300;
- (3) \$40, if the face value exceeds \$300; or
- (4) 5 percent of the face amount of the check, whichever is greater.
