Dear Florida Public Service Commission,

Two steps. First step is flat rate pricing. If you can generate a kw for 4 cents, sell it right from the generator for 5 cents. That's a 25% profit. Second step is have a cost per kw increase proportional to load, up to twice the cost at 95% load, and about 5 steps from nighttime base load. This would stimulate a load management industry. The solar sell back should track the current cost per kw based on load. So the guys that have extra kw solar capacity aren't getting shortchanged. They are generating during the peak. Pay them. You are saving the expense of running the peakers.
