Dear Florida PSC PSC,

We are in the middle of a pandemic with unemployment rampant in our state. Right now, Floridians need help making ends meet paying day-to-day expenses, including rising healthcare costs and prescription drug prices, as well as increasing rents and food costs.

What Floridians do not need now is to pay for services that benefits no more than 5 percent of ratepayers.

I am concerned that none of the SPPs complied with the PSC's own Rules (25-6-030) for such Plans, and there appears to be no strategic plan. These for-profit utilities need to be overseen to protect the public. I have been happy with Tampa Electric, my provider, but feel a more determined plan to move overhead powerlines underground should be a higher priority.
